URUHONGORE ECD ACTIVITIES

This month, on 15 July 2026, URUHONGORE Early Childhood Development (ECD) Centre marked the completion of the 2025-2026 academic year. All children enrolled in the Nursery 1, Nursery 2, and Nursery 3 successfully completed the academic year and began their school holiday.

As part of the celebration, 14 children from the Nursery 3 graduated from the ECD programme, marking an important milestone as they completed their early childhood education journey and prepared to transition to primary school as our annual commitment.



We are grateful to the children in our community school for their commitment and good academic performance, as well as to our partners and donors who support children's education.

Many families of enrolled children still face financial challenges, especially with rising school fees, meals, and learning materials. We therefore invite donors to support children's education.

RISING STARS SPORTS CENTER (RSC)

Children participating in the education through sports Program continued to benefit from the integration of education and sports through Rising Stars Sports Center.

Alongside their regular sports activities, the children successfully completed the 2025-2026 academic year and began their school holidays.

On 15 July 2026, children who achieved an average score of 70% or higher during the academic year were recognized and rewarded for their hard work, commitment, and outstanding academic performance.

This recognition celebrated their commitment to their studies and encouraged them to continue striving for excellence in education.



As part of the education through sports Program, vulnerable children receive school feeding support to help them remain engaged in education while developing their talents, discipline, teamwork, and other essential life skills through sports.

With the academic year now concluded and the children on school holiday, they will have more time to participate in regular sports training sessions at Rising Stars Sports Center.

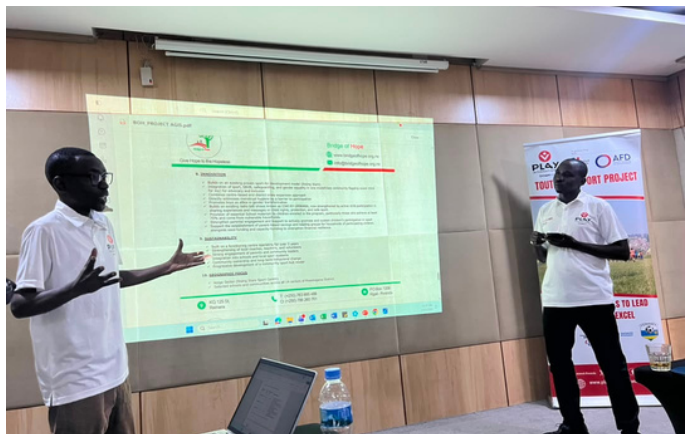
This will allow them to remain active, develop their sporting abilities, and benefit from a safe and structured environment that supports their holistic development.

PARTNERSHIP DEVELOPMENT AND MOU SIGNING WITH PLAY INTERNATIONAL

Bridge of Hope has taken another important step toward promoting gender equality through sport by signing a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with PLAY International under the All Girls in Sport Project. The partnership marks a shared commitment to empowering girls through safe, inclusive, and supportive sporting opportunities.

On 21 July 2026, Bridge of Hope participated in the project's kick-off meeting, organized by PLAY International at Grazia Apartments in Kimihurura, Kigali.

The event brought together participating Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) to introduce their organizations, gain an overview of the project, present their proposed initiatives under the incubation process, and review the implementation roadmap.



During the meeting, Bridge of Hope officially signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with PLAY International, formalizing its role in implementing the All Girls in Sport Project.

Through this partnership, Bridge of Hope will strengthen its capacity to promote girls' participation in sport while helping them develop essential life skills, discover their talents, build self-confidence, and grow as future leaders within their communities.

As the project moves forward, Bridge of Hope remains committed to working alongside partners and communities to create safe, inclusive, and empowering sporting environments where every girl has the opportunity to thrive and reach her full potential.
