ECD ACTIVITIES

Children at URUHONGORE ECD Center continue to learn and grow in a safe and nurturing environment through Bridge of Hope's Early Childhood Development program.

As the second term of 2026 progresses, they remain actively engaged in learning, having completed their midterm assessments and now preparing for their final examinations.



At URUHONGORE ECD Center, children are guided to combine learning with joyful experiences such as creative arts, storytelling, songs, and group play, building curiosity, creativity, and strong teamwork skills every day.



Through a holistic approach to early learning, children continue developing essential cognitive, social, emotional, and communication skills. Bridge of Hope remains committed to providing quality early childhood education that empowers every child to learn, explore, and thrive.

RISING STARS SPORTS CENTER (RSC)

Bridge of Hope continues to support rural children through the Rising Stars Sports Center, where they gather every weekend to train, play, and grow by supporton Education Through Sports initiative.

Via sports and mentorship, children develop important values such as discipline, cleanliness, respect, and commitment to doing well in school, helping them build positive behaviors both on and off the field.



During this period, Parents held a meeting to discuss how they can further support our children's talents and development.

As a commitment to sustainability, they agreed to contribute at least 2 kilograms of maize every month to support the program.



On 29th March, Rising Stars Academy organized friendly football matches with Golden Silver Academy aimed at developing children's talent, teamwork, discipline, and confidence, with 126 children taking part.

The day began with general knowledge sharing and discussions on good behavior to prepare the children mentally and socially.

Match results were: U10 (1-1), U13 (Golden Silver Academy 3-2 Rising Stars Academy), and U15 (Rising Stars Academy 4-0 Golden Silver Academy).

The event highlighted strong performance, effort, and sportsmanship, with appreciation extended to all children, parents, coaches, partners, and supporters of the Education Through Sports initiative.



TECH FORWARD LIVE CONFERENCE (SAN TECH)

On 6 March 2026, the Bridge of Hope team participated in Tech Forward Live Day, organized by San Tech Hub, gaining insights on how to leverage technology for community development and social impact.

Inspired by the event, and in collaboration with San Tech Hub, we are planning a Community Technology Hub a safe space where children and youth can engage with digital tools, develop skills, explore talents, enhance learning, practice coding, and build confidence in responsible technology use.

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GRANT PROPOSAL WRITING TRAINING

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DISTRIBUTION OF WATER FILTERS TO SCHOOLS

On 27 March 2026, Bridge of Hope continued its ongoing initiative of distributing water filters to five schools in Gatsibo District, providing safe and clean drinking water to 8,614 students 4,961 boys and 3,653 girls.

The supported schools include GS Rugerama, GS Mulinga, GS Gakenke, GS Akabuga, and Alfredo School.

This achievement was made possible through the support of our partners, generous donors, and the local community, all working together to help children stay healthy, happy, and focused in school.



Through our “Safe Water for Every Child” project, students now enjoy improved health, better hygiene, and safer drinking water.

Bridge of Hope remains committed to ensuring every child learns and grows in a healthy and safe environment.



Looking ahead, we are expanding our impact with a clear goal to reach 100,000 children with safe and clean water between 2026 and 2028.

Together, we are building lasting change one school, one student, and one drop of water at a time.

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ONGOING ACTIVITY FOR THE FANDRAISING FOR SCHOOL FEEDING AT OUR COMMUNITY BASED SCHOOL

As we have always supported children studying at our community based school known as URUHONGORE ECD Center, we continue to strengthen our efforts to ensure they receive nutritious and balanced meals that help them grow well and learn effectively.

This March, we are mobilizing \$1,000 to support the school feeding program. This initiative plays a key role in improving children's health, increasing school attendance, and enhancing their learning outcomes.
